THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BLUEWATER

BY-LAW NO. 29-2004

Being a by-law to prohibit the depositing of refuse or debris in certain areas of the Municipality pursuant to Section 127.of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25, S.127 provides that the Council of a Municipality may prohibit the depositing of refuse or debris on land without the consent of the owner or occupant of the land;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Bluewater deems it necessary to prohibit illegal dumping;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Bluewater enacts as follows:

- 1. Definitions:
 - **1.1** "**Debris**" means fragments of something that has been destroyed or broken down.
 - 1.2 "Refuse" means food waste and/or unwanted or unused material.
 - **1.3 "Yard Waste"** means grass cuttings, tree branches, trimmings from bushes, shrubs or flower beds.
- 2. There shall be no dumping of refuse, debris or yard waste on road allowances or municipal property.
- **3.** Yard waste may be deposited at designated sites identified by Municipal signs.
- **4.** Any person who breaches this By-law is guilty of an offence and subject to a penalty as provided under the "Provincial Offences Act".
- 5. That this By-law shall come into effect on its passing.

Read a first and second time this 12th day of July, 2004.

Read a third time and finally passed this 12th day of July, 2004.
